At FOIH, we were able to provide maximum support for the provision of quality healthcare – absolutely free of cost in Pakistan through Indus Hospital & Health Network.



We were able to mobilize medical camps, diagnostic labs, emergency treatments, free medicines, and immediate assistance to pregnant mothers using our mobile medical trucks, clinics on wheels, and our boat clinic. At FOIH, we went into high gear and organized multiple fundraisers in various cities in the United States to collect funds for these life-saving emergency relief efforts.
