Thanks to the incredible support from our donors, we achieved remarkable progress in Pakistan this quarter. These milestones are a testament to the life-changing impact of your contributions.


Launch of the State-of-the-Art Emergency Facility at Korangi











IHHN achieved a groundbreaking milestone with the launch of its new Emergency Room (ER) at the Korangi Campus. The event marked the first step of the first phase of Pakistan's largest free-of-cost private sector hospital, setting a new benchmark in delivering world-class healthcare to underserved communities. The state-of-the-art facility now **serves 500,000 patients** annually, doubling its previous capacity. Key features include dedicated resuscitation bays for critical emergencies, separate halls for adult and pediatric patients to ensure specialized care, and fast-track clinics aimed at managing non-critical cases efficiently. This expansion addresses Karachi's growing healthcare needs, ensuring advanced emergency care for the community.

Family Medicine Clinics Operational at the New Hospital Facility



emphasize preventive health measures while facilitating timely referrals to specialist consultants for more complex cases. With 117 clinics now operational, the facility is expected to serve over 1.16 million patients annually, thanks to the generous support of donors and the Sindh Government.
